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The port of Vilagarcía, which comprises a total area ofapproximately 575,000 square meters, enjoys a strategic location, in the center of the Galician Atlantic coast.

Our location allows us to meet the demands of a wide hinterland, which covers the entire northwest and center of the peninsula. We have direct access to the AP-9 motorway through a road that also functions as the southern ring road for Vilagarcía, and an excellent connection with the rest of the O Salnés region through a high-capacity corridor.

As regards the railway, the internal railway network of the port covers all the commercial docks, connecting by means of a 1.2 km branch to the conventional railway network through line 818 Vilagarcía-Bifurcación de Angueira (Padrón).








### **MAIN TRAFFICS**

One of the most outstanding characteristics of the port of Vilagarcía is the diversification of its traffics, of which bulk cargo accounts together for almost half. In 2021, dry bulk commodities represented 28.3 % of the total merchandise in maritime traffic, and liquid bulk, the remaining 18.2 %. The total tonnes moved through docks belonging to the Port of Vilagarcía in that year was 1.5 million.

Among dry bulk stand out quartz, coming from quarries in our surroundings and which is exported through the Arousan docks, as well as products related to construction, among which cement -unloaded by means of specialzed equipment- is the most important. The port of Vilagarcía also supplies important industries located in the interior of Galicia, and which import cereals through the port of Arousa for the production of animal feed.

Regarding liquid bulk, the port has two terminals, dedicated to the storage of oil for human consumption, and the storage of methanol and petroleum products, respectively.

## At the service of our hinterland



The Port of Vilagarcía is a logistics platform that facilitates and enhances the industrial activity of a large number of companies in our area of influence. Its operators have capacity and experience in handling various types of merchandise.

#### **DOCKS AND INFRASTRUCTURES**

Total lenght of quays in the Port of Vilagarcía is almost 3,000 metres. Most docks (seven out of nine, totaling 2.665 metres of length) have a depth of water of 11-13 metres. We have infrastructures for the handling of general merchandise (including containerized cargo), dry bulk (also by specialized equipment), and liquid bulk.

#### **TERMINALS AND AVAILABLE AREAS**

For the correct development of port operations, the Port of Vilagarcía has several terminals focused on a certain type of traffic, as well as large dockside areas for storage, both covered and uncovered. There are also available plots in port public domain, for those port operators interested in settling in Vilagarcía,
